

# SYRAH

## a) Flavours of Syrah/ Shiraz

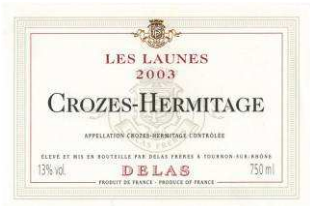
This **black grape variety** is known as Shiraz in Australia and Syrah in the rest of the world. The grapes are small with thick dark colour skins. They grow in moderate to hot climate. It gives deeply coloured wines, with medium or high level of tannins and acidity. **The wine is usually full bodied and generally has a black fruit and dark chocolate character.** Many Syrah wines undergo some **oak treatment**.



## a) Premium Syrah/ Shiraz regions

◆ The **Northern Rhône in France**: this is the **classic region for Syrah wines**. The best appellations are: Côte-Rotie, Hermitage and Crozes-Hermitage. The finest wines are made from grapes grown on the steep terraces above the Rhône. Many of those are so narrow that no machinery can be used, and **the vineyard work has to be done by hand, which makes wine expensive to produce.**
